**CURB surprises the Queen with 9ft tall, 140ft square Windsor castle**



**15th June: Natural media company CURB is always looking for new and innovative ways in which to reach the British public. This time they reached the very top – The Queen.**

**CURB built a stunning sand replica of the Queen's home to mark her first visit to Weymouth in 50 years. The impressive sculpture, which boasts 20 turrets and 18 separate sections of wall, is modeled exactly on a 40:1 scale from the royal plans.**
